
Resumes in October

We often speak as if the Trinity was a great mystery that was seldom referred to. Yet every time we bless ourselves, we do it not in the name of Jesus alone, but in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit! That is the Trinity.

Notice this week how often our prayers refer to the Father, Son and Spirit - notice Trinity present in the 'Glory be' prayer, and in the opening and closing rites of our Mass. Notice how we call on all three persons of the Trinity in the Doxology (Through him, with him & in him, in the unity ...)

We are continually recognising that God is not just one who loves, God IS love. God is three persons in one, bound by love, and we are invited into the love of God.



Lord Jesus, you promised to be present where two or three gather in your name.



May your presence and guidance be with the Irish Augustinians who have come together in this Chapter meeting.
