The Countdown to WMOF 2018 Begins

Mass to celebrate the one year countdown to the World Meeting of Families 2018 in Ireland Families and individuals from across Ireland travelled to Knock, Co Mayo, on Monday 21st August to be part of the celebrations for the official launch of the preparatory programme and to mark the one year countdown to next year's World Meeting of Families 2018.

The WMOF2018 Icon of the Holy Family was unveiled and anointed at Mass in the basilica. The official prayer for WMOF2018 was also presented at the Mass. The Amoris: Let's talk Family! Let's Be Family! Programme was also launched. Using a range of online and parish based resources, this programme will offer families, parishes and wider society an opportunity to think about and discuss our vision and hopes for family and marriage, particularly in light of Pope Francis' The Joy of Love (Amoris Laetitia), his 2016 Apostolic Exhortation on love in the family.

Archbishop Diarmuid Martin said in the homily, "God's love reaches out to all. We have an obligation to preach the Gospel of love to all. There is no family that is ideal. Plates fly in every family. There are however great families who struggle, at times heroically. The celebration of a World Meeting of Families would be hypocritical were it to be a celebration that ignored this struggle. A civilization of love must involve the search for a new politics for families, a politics of care for the marginalised and those who struggle."


