Rejoice and be Glad

Pope Francis has released his third Apostolic Exhortation to the faithful: "*Gaudete et Exsultate*" (Rejoice and be glad), subtitled "*On the call to holiness in the contemporary world*"

An Apostolic Exhortation is considered one of the highest ranking papal documents, after Encyclical Letters. Since his election as Pope, Francis has issued two other Exhortations: "Evangelii Gaudium" in 2013 and "Amoris Laetitia" in 2016.

Pope Francis says of this Exhortation: "*My modest goal is to re-propose the call to holiness in a practical way for our own time, with all its risks, challenges and opportunities. For the Lord has chosen each one of us "to be holy and blameless before him in love" (Eph 1:4).*" This new Exhortation will be available in the Abbey Bookshop next week.
