Coral 'San Agustin' Madrid



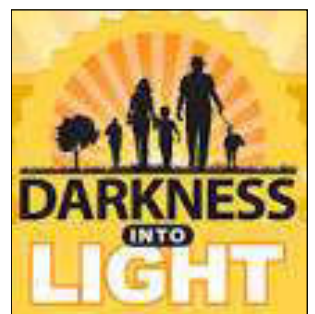
