Our story is about how one young English man's response to Pope John Paul II's call in 1989 changed the world. Ernest Williams formed Youth 2000. Youth 2000, commenced in Ireland in 1993.and has spread to more than 25 countries all over the world, changing the lives of thousands of young people. 
