# We turn to our Lady of Perpetual Help

Limerick Redemptorist rector, Fr Seamus Enright said \_the people of Limerick have invoked the protection of Our Lady of Perpetual Help in times of difficulty for more than 150 years'.

A candle of intercession was lit by Bishop Brendan Leahy during St Patrick's Day Mass in the Redemptorists Church on St Patrick's Day. Prayers were said at the Shrine of Our Lady of Perpetual Help for those suffering from the Covid-19 pandemic and for those who are on the frontline fighting it.

"We are now in a time of great need not just here in Limerick but across the world due to the Covid-19 pandemic

—Atsuch times we turn to Our Lady and the lighting of the candle is Bishop Leahy's invitation to the faithful to take part in the nationwide Novena in this time of COVID -19 crisis," said Fr Enright.

The Novena will culminate with the Consecration of Ireland to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on March 25th, the Feast Day of the Annunciation.
