LECTIO DIVINA-THE WORD OF GOD AS LIVING WORD

Lectio Divina is a method of prayer and Scripture reflection which allows participants to study the Bible in small groups and see it's relevance in their own lives. This is done through reading the piece of Scripture, spending time in silence and then listening to the sharing of others and sharing if you wish. It is important to mention, that while each member of the group is given an opportunity to share, nobody has to speak and some people choose not to do so. It is important also to say that you do not need to be an expert, or have any academic knowledge of Scripture to join this group.

There are no experts and no rights or wrongs.

Lay members of this congregation have been using this method of prayer and met together, with people who attend other Augustinian churches, from Lent this year until Pentecost. Their time of reflection was followed by a two day retreat in Glenstal Abbey which was both prayerful and enjoyable. Would you like to join us and experience this beautiful method of prayer?
