Bishops have asked that church bells would be rung at 9.00am on Sunday 12th December in prayerful hope for all during this Season of Advent. Sunday 12th December has been chosen as it is the Third Sunday of Advent which is Gaudete (Rejoicing) Sunday.



The bishops extended the invitation following their Winter General Meeting which concluded online on Wednesday 1 December. At their meeting the bishops also reflected on the past year and looked ahead to Christmas. They said, "Bishops said, "As Christmas approaches, we keep especially in our thoughts those who have been bereaved in the past year, and we pray for the gifts of healing and hope for all. We have now begun our Advent journey, a time of patient waiting and joyful hope. Prepare for the Journey

Christmas celebrates the God with us – "Emmanuel". Advent celebrates the God who sends us out and also comes to receive us. It is the same God who fulfils both functions. As we celebrate Advent, and as our minds are very much tuned in to celebrating the God with us, born in the manger at Christmas, let us not forget the God who invites us to journey, to become, to be transformed. It is the same God. But if we do not choose to journey with the infant of Bethlehem, along the path of discipleship that will also lead us through his cross to the resurrection, then the great message of Christmas might well be lost. This, after all, is what our preparation is all about. We do not prepare for the birth of Christ – that has already happened. We prepare ourselves for the journey that is our discipleship. And Advent reminds us that this discipleship is our response to God's call so that, just as God is with us (Emmanuel), so, we will strive to be with God (faithful disciples).
